

Ordinance of Tax Levies

An Ordinance Levying Taxes and fixing the Rate of Taxation for the purpose of raising revenue to meet the necessary expense for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1969.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of Bloomington, Monroe County, (Name of City)

Indiana, That:

There shall be levied upon each One Hundred Dollars of the Assessed Valuation of Taxable Property of the above named city for the fiscal year 1968, to be collected in the year 1969, the following:

For GENERAL FUND, the sum of 3.10 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property and 0 dollars on each Taxable Poll.

For STREET FUND, the sum of 0 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For BOND AND INTEREST REDEMPTION FUND, the sum of 8 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For Cemetery FUND, the sum of 5 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For Parks & Recreation FUND, the sum of 33 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For Police Pension FUND, the sum of 11 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For Fire Pension FUND, the sum of 21 cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.

For _____ FUND, the sum of _____ cents on each one hundred dollars of Taxable Property.
