ORDINANCE NO. 68-56

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of
Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County,
Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point
on the now existing Corporation Line, said point being the
intersection of the South Right-of-Way Line of State Road
No. 48 and the East Line of the said Northeast Quarter of
the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township and Range aforesaid;
thence South to a point on said East Quarter, Quarter Line that
is 330 feet South of the North line of said Section 1; thence
West 223.03 feet; thence North 173.43 feet; thence South 89 degrees,
02 minutes, 30 seconds East to the West Right-of-Way Line of the
Curry Pike; thence Northerly on and along said West Right-of-Way
Line of Curry Pike to the South Right-of-Way Line of State Highway
No. 48 and the existing Corporation Line; thence East to the point
of beginning.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and
publication in accordance with the law.
