AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957, ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" BY AMENDING SECTION 193 THEREOF ENTITLED "ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS" AND SECTION 206 THEREOF ENTITLED "STOP INTERSECTIONS"

SECTION 1. That Section 193 of Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, be amended by adding thereto the following:

> 1. West Wylie Street shall be one-way West from Rogers Street to Fairview Street.

SECTION 2. That Section 206 of Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, entitled "Stop Intersections" shall be amended by adding thereto the following:

- 1. Queens Way shall stop for High Street.
- 2. Sussex Drive shall stop for Queens Way.
- 3. Chelsey Court shall stop for Queens Way.
- 4. Montclair shall stop for Queens Way North and South bound.
- 5. Sussex Drive shall stop for Montclair.
- 6. Wimbleton Lane shall stop for Montclair.
- 7. Wimbleton Lane shall stop for High Street.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
