ORDINANCE NO. 68-75

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND  
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION  
FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is  
adjacent to the real estate described herein and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have  
submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory  
of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and  
the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of  
Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the south half of the Southwest quarter of  
Section 21, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe  
County, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning  
on the South line of the Southwest quarter of said Section  
21, at a point that is 1584 feet West of the Southeast  
corner of the said Southwest quarter of said Section 21,  
running thence East along the South line of said Southwest  
quarter a distance of 232 feet to the center line of the  
North State Highway #37, running thence in a northwesterly  
direction along the center line of said North State Highway  
#37 a distance of 65 feet; running thence West a distance of  
232 feet; running thence Southeasterly and parallel to the  
center line of a new state highway #37 to the place of  
beginning; Also, a part of the northwest quarter of the  
northwest quarter of Section 28, township 9 North, range  
1 west, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described  
as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of the  
North section line and the center line of new state highway  
#37, said point being 1352 1/2 feet west of a stake at the  
northeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 28;  
thence in a southeasterly direction on and along the center  
of said new state highway #37 as it curves to the right  
152.7 feet; thence West 414.5 feet to the east line of the  
land previously sold to John J. Hinkle; thence in a North-  
westerly direction parallel to and 99 feet from the center  
of old state highway #37; along the east line of the land  
sold to John J. Hinkle to the north section line; thence  
east on and along the north section line 404.3 feet to  
the place of beginning. The above described containing 1.35  
acres, more or less. Except that part of said lands that  
lie within the right-of-way of State Highway #37 which is  
now a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

These lands are located on the West side of State Highway  
#37 North of the City of Bloomington, Indiana and immediately  
North of the Marathon Service Station. They are contiguous  
to the existing corporation line on both the South and the  
East.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the  
City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be  
extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described  
as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and  
publication in accordance with the law.
