AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY PURSUANT TO THE FILING OF A PETITION FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION.

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is adjacent to the real estate described herein; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows; to-wit: Beginning at a point on the now existing corporation line, said point being the intersection of the west line of said quarter quarter with the north line of State Highway #45; thence east on and along said north line of State Highway #45 a distance of 660 feet; thence north 0 degrees and 44 minutes west for a distance of 1300 feet, more or less, and to the north line of said quarter quarter. Thence, west for a distance of 660 feet and to the existing corporation line; thence south 0 degrees and 44 minutes east for a distance of 1300 feet, more or less, and to the point of beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less.

This land is located north of Tenth Street and east of the Pistol Range Road.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
