

ORDINANCE NO. 67-29

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 66-36 concerning municipal salaries and wages.

WHEREAS, The City of Bloomington and the County of Monroe have entered into an agreement by which the City is to furnish animal control services to the County of Monroe; and,

WHEREAS, from the appropriation made for such purpose by the Board of Commissioners of Monroe County, there are funds available to employ and pay part-time assistants at the animal shelter.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 66-36 of the City of Bloomington be amended by adding thereto the following:

- a. Animal Shelter -- Part-Time Employees -- \$1.50 to \$2.25 per hour.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, and publication in accordance with the law.


