

ORDINANCE NO. 67-31

An ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:


A part of the East half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning on the West line of said East half Quarter Section at a point Three Hundred Sixty-three (363) feet North of the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section Ten (10); thence South on and along said West half Section line to the North line of the Winslow Road; thence East on and along said Winslow Road North line and said line extended to the East line of South High Street; thence North on and along the East line of High Street to a point that is due East of a point on the East line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section Ten (10) and Nine Hundred Seventy-five (975) feet South of the North line of said Quarter Section; thence West to the point of beginning. Containing fifty-one (51) acres more or less.

This property is located at the Northwest corner of Winslow Road and South High Street.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, publication and approval by the Mayor.


