SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

AN ORDINANCE FIXING SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1968.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That from and after the first day of January 1968, the salary and pay schedule for appointed officers and employees of Bloomington, Indiana, be fixed as follows:


