ORDINANCE NO. 67-61

An ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

The East one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section two (2), Township eight (8) North, Range one (1) West.

Also, the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section two (2), township and range aforesaid, containing in the three quarter quarter sections, one of which is fractional, a total of One Hundred and Twelve (112) acres, more or less.

This is the Latimer farm located on the South side of East Third Street between Hoosier Acres and the College Mall.

SECTION 2. BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, publication and approval by the Mayor.
