

ORDINANCE NO. 66-27

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN PUBLIC AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to operate a motor vehicle across any part of any park, picnic ground, golf course, or area not designed and intended to be used by motor vehicles, which said park, picnic ground, golf course, or area is owned by the City of Bloomington or any governmental agency within the City.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, and publication in accordance with the law.
