

ORDINANCE NO. 66-32, 1966

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLACING OF OBJECTS
AND ERECTION OF SIGNS UPON SIDEWALKS AND IN
THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of
Bloomington:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or firm
to place any advertising sign or display any merchandise upon
any sidewalk, tree plot or public right of way.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication
in accordance with the law.
