

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 66-1

An Ordinance specially appropriating from the General Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and reduction of funds theretofore appropriated for the use of Departments of said City, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various departments:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the General Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1966, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:

- 1. Police Department
 - #57 - Clothing \$2,000.00
- TOTAL GENERAL FUND \$ 2,000.00

SECTION 2. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Special Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1966, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:


- 1. Motor Vehicle Fund - Street
 - #263 - Other Contractual Service \$11,000.00
 - # 52 - Rents 1,200.00
 - #722 - Motor Equipment 5,000.00
- TOTAL SPECIAL FUNDS \$17,200.00


SECTION 3. That there be, and hereby is, reduced from the General Funds of said City for reason that the amount previously appropriated is in excess of actual needs at this time, and this amount may be returned to the unappropriated funds as follows:

- 1. Police Department
 - #726 - Other Equipment \$ 2,000.00
- TOTAL REDUCTIONS IN GENERAL FUND \$ 2,000.00


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, this 3rd day of March, 1966.




