

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON
COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA
ORDINANCE NO. 64-21

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON
ZONING MAP DATED JULY 18, 1950

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, said zoning ordinance and map are now incorporated in the "Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957", as Chapter 30 of said code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has recommended that said Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain properties, now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMONG COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174, ACTS OF 1947, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone the following described land in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, from its present R-2 TWO FAMILY ZONE classification to a B-3 GENERAL BUSINESS ZONE, to-wit:

Lots numbered 14, 15, 16, and 17 in Railroad Park Addition to the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana. Said lots are located on the East side of College Avenue between Hillside Drive and Southern Drive.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
