

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
64-4

An Ordinance specially appropriating from the General Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and reduction of funds heretofore appropriated for the use of Departments of said City, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various departments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE
COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION I.
