

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 64-5

An Ordinance specially appropriating from the Special Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and reduction of funds heretofore appropriated for the use of Departments of said City, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various departments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Special Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1964, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriation as finally made, the following sums:

1. Parking Meter (Police Fund)		
#11 Salaries and Wages	\$3200.00	\$3200.00
2. Park and Recreation Department		
#22 Heat, Light, Power, Etc.	1.00	
#25 Repairs	1.50	2.50
TOTAL SPECIAL FUNDS		\$3202.50

SECTION 2. That there be, and hereby is, reduced from the Special Funds of said City for reason that the amount previously appropriated is in excess of actual needs at this time, and this amount may be returned to the unappropriated funds as follows:

1. Parking Meter (Street Fund)		
#11 Salaries and Wages	\$3200.00	\$3200.00
2. Park and Recreation Department		
#24 Printing and Advertising	2.50	2.50
TOTAL SPECIAL FUNDS REDUCTION		\$3202.50

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
