

## ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1963

An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the now existing corporation line, said point being the point where the west line of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West extended, meets the south right-of-way line of State Highway Number Forty-six (46); thence east on and along said south right-of-way line of State Highway Number Forty-six (46) to the east line of the southwest quarter of said Section Thirty-six (36); thence north on and along the east line of said southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) to a point Eleven hundred (1100) feet north of the southeast corner of the north half of the southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West; thence west to the south right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Railroad; thence southwesterly on and along said south right-of-way line of the Illinois Central Railroad to the west line of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West; thence south on and along the west line of said Section Thirty-six (36) to the existing corporation line and continuing south on and along said existing corporation line to the point of beginning at the point where said corporation line and west line of said Section Thirty-six (36) extended meets the south right-of-way line of State Highway Number Forty-six (46).

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
