ORDINANCEEOF THE CITY OR BLOOMINGTON COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 6 , 1963

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomingtan, Indiana, 1957, by amending Chapter 5 entitled YAnimals and Foul", Section 10 thereof entitied "Rumning at large -. Vicious, etc.; femailes in heat; impounding; killing when nesessary" and Section 11 thereofentitled "Uilicensed dogs."

BE IT ORDAINED BY : THE COMMON COUNCIL OF PHE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 10 of Chapter 5, entitled "Ruming at Large - Vicious, etc.; females in heat; impounding; killing when necessary" be amerded to read as follows:

No dog shall be allowed to run at large or upon the premiees of one other than the owner. If any such dog is found runningat large in violation of this provision, it shall be taken up and impounded and shall be released only after payment of the fees provided in section E-15 of this Code; provided, however, that if any dangerous, fierce or vicious dog so found at large cannot be safely taken up and impounded, such dog may be slain by any policeman or humane officer or assistant.

SECRION 2. That Section 11 of Chapter 5, entitled "Uulicensed dogs" be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5-11. Owner's Responsibility.
No owner or keeper of any dog shall permit such dog to run at large.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
