

ORDINANCE NO. 10, 1963

An Ordinance concerning the annexation  
of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,  
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be,  
and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City  
of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest quarter of Section 35,  
Township 9 North, Range 1 West, described as  
follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point that is  
704.2 feet West of the Southeast corner of the  
said Southwest quarter of Section 35, Township  
and Range aforesaid; thence running North for a  
distance of 277 feet; thence running North 87  
degrees West for a distance of 199½ feet;  
thence running South for a distance of 288 feet  
and to the Bloomington and Perry Township line;  
thence running east over and along the said  
township line for a distance of 199½ feet and  
to the place of beginning, containing in all 1.29  
acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries  
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby  
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate  
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and  
effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication  
in accordance with the law.
