An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory pursuant to the filing of voluntary petitions for annexation.

WHEREAS, the boundary of the Cityof Bloomington, Indiana,
is along and adjacent to the real estate described herein; and,
WIPREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have submitted to the Comm Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory of Wichthe petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDATNED BY TTE CONOON COUNCTE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTON I. That the following described territory be,
and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and a part of the Southeast quarter of the Morthwest quarter, all being in Section 9 , Tomship 8 Morth, Range I West, in Monroe County, Indiana described as follows, tomit: Beginning at the Southeast comer of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter: thence running North 2 degrees 38 minutes West for 2498 feet, and to the Southeast comer of Charles Pierson real estate (Deed Record No. 107, page 192), thence running West over and along the South line property Iine of said Pierson real estate for 327 feet and to the Southwest corner of the said Charles Pierson feal estate; thence running Forth over and along the West Iine of the said Charles Pierson real estate for a distance of 142 feet and to the 耳orth line of the said Southeast quarter of the Northrest quarter; thence running West over and ajong the said North line of the said Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter for a distance of 778 feet to the Northeast corner of the South Gate Shipping Center real estate; thence leaving the Morth line of the said Southeast quarter of the Northvest quarter and running South 13 degrees 19 minutes East over and along the East property line of the South Gate Shopping Center real estate and the Zast property line of the Ratherine Fee Hoadley Real Estate for a distance of 633 feet and to the Southeast corner of the said Katherine Fee Hoadley real estate; thence running Bast for a distance of 68 feet; thence ruming South 2 degrees 38 minutes Fast for a distance of 2067.28 feet, and to the South line of the said Mortheast quarter of the Southwest quarter; thence munimg Bast over and along the said South Iine of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter for a distance of 903.27 feet and to the place of beginning, containing in all 55.57 acres, more or less.

ALSO, a part of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, and a part of the Southeast quarter of Morthwest Gutarter, all in Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiam, described as follows, towit: Beginning at a point that is 903.27 feet West of the Southeast comer of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, thence runing West for 143 feet and to the Fast right-of-way line of State Highway No. 37; thence running over and along the said East right-of-way line of State Highway No. 37, the following courses and distances,

North 11 degrees 14 minutes West for 152 feet; thence West for 5 feet; thence North 11 degrees 14 minutes West for 456.7 feet; thence East for 5 feet, thence North 13 degrees 19 minutes West for 90 feet; thence West for 5 feet; thence running North 13 degrees 19 minutes West for 658 feet; thence East for 5 feet, thence Nor th 13 degrees 19 minutes West for 300 feet and to the South line of Katherine Fee Hoadley tract; thence leaving the said East right of way Ine of the said State Highway No. 37 and muning East over and along the South line of the said Katherine Fee Hoadley tract for 498.5 feet and to the Southeast corner of the said Katherine Fee Hoadley tract; thence continuing East for 68 feet: thence South 2 degrees 38 minutes East for 2067.28 feet and to the place of beginning, containing in all 15.06 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHTR ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
