AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF REAL ESTATE FOR THE WATER WORKS DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Public Works and Safety be, and it is hereby, authorized and directed to purchase the following described real estate, to-wit:

> A part of the West Half of South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, described as follows: Commencing on the North line of said lot, Forty-six (46) feet East of the Northwest corner thereof; thence running East Fifty-two (52) feet; thence South to a point on the South line thereof Ninety-eight (98) feet East of the Southwest corner thereof, thence West Fifty-two (52) feet on the South line thereof, thence North Seventy-five (75) feet, more or less, and to the North line of said lot, and to the place of beginning,

for the sum of Twenty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$27,500.00) for the use and benefit of the City Water Works Department.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
