

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON
COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 7, 1962

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, by repealing the regulations contained in Section 15, 17, 18, 19 and 20, of Article II of Chapter 19; and by adding Sections 19-31, 19-32 and 19-33.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Sections 15, 17, 18, 19, and 20 of Article II of Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957 be hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That a new Section 31 of Article II of Chapter 19 be adopted as follows:

(a) The Municipal Parking Lot commonly known as the Day Parking Lot located at Seventh and Walnut Streets be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 2.

(b) The Municipal Parking Lot commonly known as Kerr Parking Lot, located at Fourth and Washington Streets, be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 3.

(c) The off-street parking lot located on the following described lands shall be named and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 4:

In Lots Number Eighty-three (83) and Eighty-four (84) (Fourth and Morton Streets) to the City of Bloomington, Indiana, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

(d) The off-street parking lot located on the following described lands shall be named and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 5:

In Lots Number One Hundred Eighty-five (185) and One Hundred Eighty-six (186) to the City of Bloomington, (at Sixth and Lincoln Streets), as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

SECTION 3. That a new Section 32 of Article II of Chapter 19 be adopted as follows:

"The charge for the use of Municipal Parking Lots No. 2, No. 3, No. 4 and No. 5 shall be five cents (5¢) per hour of part thereof for the use of each space for the 24 hour period of each day. The charge of five cents per hour shall be collected by parking meters installed thereon and any person parking a motor vehicle thereon shall deposit coins of the United States as follows: Five cents for each 60 minutes period or fraction thereof. The provision of this section shall not apply from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Sundays."

SECTION 4. That a new Section 33 of Article No. 2 of Chapter 19 be adopted as follows:

"(a) Parking privileges shall be made available to all eligible motorists at their election, to park in any of the City parking lots on a rental basis as follows: At the rate of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) annually (calendar basis); all sums payable in advance.

"The City shall furnish for each motor vehicle upon the application for such parking privilege and upon payment as hereinabove set out, a permit showing the payment therefor. All motor vehicles which display such a permit on the lower right hand corner of the windshield may park in any available stall in any of the City Municipal Parking Lots. All motor vehicles so parked are subject to all the provisions of all prior ordinances concerning the City parking lots.

"It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer to issue the permit and collect and account for the rents received therefrom, and deposit such monies to the credit of the City in a special fund provided by law for parking meter receipts."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
