SPECIAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1960

An Ordinance specially appropriating from the Parking Meter Fund not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana to meet the emergencies found to exist in this Department.
