An Ordinance to Amend the Bloomington Zoning Map, Dated July 18, 1950

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain property, now

THEREFORE, BE IN ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to reclassify Lots numbered 12, 13, 14, and 15 in Lowe's Addition; also, that part of the vacated street that lays between Lots No. 15 and No. 16 in said Lowe's Addition; also, all the properties in Seminary Lot No. 63, that abutt the west side of Walnut Street and are not now zoned B3 General Business; all in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, from their present B1 LIMITED BUSINESS ZONE classification to a B3 GENERAL BUSINESS ZONE.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
