

ORDINANCE NO. 6, 1958

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL an Ordinance Entitled,
 "An Ordinance Declaring and Defining the Entire
 Corporate Boundaries of the City of Bloomington,
 Monroe County, Indiana."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
 OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of
 Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, passed and adopted Ordinance
 No. 4, 1958, providing for declaring and defining of the entire
