

ORDINANCE NO. 8, 1958

An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory pursuant to the filing of a voluntary petition for annexation.

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is along and adjacent to the real estate described herein, and

WHEREAS, the owner of the lands hereinafter described has submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on her behalf for annexation of certain territory of which the petitioner is the owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the North half of Seminary Lot Number One Hundred and Thirty-four (134), bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point Five Hundred and Fifty (550.0) feet East and Five Tenths (0.5) feet North of the Southwest corner of the said North half of said Seminary lot, thence North 89 degrees 18 minutes East for a distance of Four Hundred (400.0) feet, thence South for a distance of One Hundred and Forty-two and Nineteen Hundredths (142.19) feet, thence East for a distance of Three Hundred Seventy and Twenty-eight Hundredths (370.28) feet, said line being the North line of the proposed extension of Southdown Drive, and to the center line of South High Street, thence South for a distance of Five Hundred and Twenty-four (524.0) feet, over and along the centerline of South High Street, and to the South line of South half of the said Seminary Lot Number One Hundred Thirty-four, thence West for a distance of Seven Hundred and Sixty-nine and Seventy-five Hundredths (769.75) feet, over and along said South line, thence North Six Hundred and Fifty-nine and to the place of beginning, containing 10.45 acres, more or less. Said Seminary Lot Number One Hundred and Thirty-four (134), being a sub-division of a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 3, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington, shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
