

ORDINANCE NO. 24, 1958

AN Ordinance providing for the impounding of motor vehicles for successive parking violations and providing for the method of redemption of same.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, THAT:

SECTION 1. Whenever a car, truck or motor vehicle is illegally parked on the streets or in an off-street parking lot of the City of Bloomington and there shall be held by the proper authority of the City of Bloomington five (5) or more unpaid parking violations for such car, truck or motor vehicle, the Police of the City of Bloomington shall cause such car, truck or motor vehicle to be removed to a garage or place of storage within the City of Bloomington, and the same shall not be released until the owner thereof shall produce to the Police Department of the City of Bloomington proper evidence of ownership and shall pay all unpaid parking violations against said car, truck or motor vehicle, together with the costs of the impounding of said vehicle.

SECTION 2. For the purposes of this ordinance "illegally parked" shall be defined as any violation of the parking provisions of any ordinance pertaining to on or off-street parking within the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
