

An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory pursuant to the filing of a voluntary petition for annexation.

WHEREAS, the southeastern boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is along and adjacent to the real estate described herein, and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory of which the petitioners are the owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Seminary Lot Number One Hundred Thirty-five (135), beginning at a point that is Four Hundred Seven (407) feet East and Six Hundred Thirty-nine (639) feet North of the Southwest corner of said Seminary Lot Number One Hundred Thirty-five (135); thence running East for a distance of Three Hundred Thirty-six (336) feet; thence running South for a distance of Six Hundred Twenty-seven and three tenths (627.3) feet and to the North right of way of East Hillside Drive; thence running North Eighty-nine (89) degrees Eighteen (18) minutes West over and along the said North right of way of East Hillside Drive for a distance of Three Hundred Thirty-six (336) feet; thence running North for a distance of Six Hundred Twenty-three (623) feet and to the place of beginning, containing in all Four and eighty-three hundredths (4.83) acres, more or less, and being the present sub-division known as Manor Woods Addition, and comprising fourteen (14) lots in all.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
