

ORDINANCE NO. 12, 1957

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 18, 1953, as it pertains to the charges for use of the Central Parking Lot.

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington adopted Ordinance No. 18, 1953, on the 18th day of August, 1953, which said Ordinance contained certain provisions with respect to charges for the use of the Central Parking Lot; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington has determined that such Ordinance, as originally written, should be modified by the adding of the following sections to said Ordinance without otherwise modifying or changing the existing provisions of said Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. Section 5A is hereby added to said Ordinance and reads as follows, to-wit:

Parking privileges shall be made available to all eligible motorists at their election to park in said Central Parking Lot on a rental basis as follows: At the rate of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per calendar quarter for each motor vehicle in lieu of meter charges as set forth in Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Ordinance 18, 1953. That the City shall furnish for each motor vehicle upon the payment of said Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) quarterly charge a decal showing the payment therefor. (The initial purchase by any owner of a motor vehicle shall be pro rated for the quarter in which such decal is purchased.) That all motor vehicles which display such decal on the lower right hand corner of the windshield may park in any stall of said lot when stalls are available. That all motor vehicles so parking are subject to all of the provisions of all prior ordinances concerning said lot except those pertaining to payment for use of said lot. That if any motorist elects to exercise the rental privileges as set forth in this section, Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 18, 1953, shall not be applicable to said motorist.

SECTION 2. Section 5B is hereby added to said Ordinance and reads as follows, to-wit:

That it shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer to issue said decals and collect and account for the rents received therefrom, and deposit the same to the credit of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, in the special fund provided by law for parking meter receipts.

SECTION 3. That nothing in these additional sections shall repeal or revoke any existing provisions in Ordinance No. 18, 1953, passed on the 18th day of August, 1953.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and publication in accordance with the law.
