

ORDINANCE NO. 18, 1957

Amendment of an Ordinance and the Amendment thereto, concerning the maintenance of Rose Hill Cemetery and establishing charges to be made for interment and also establishing the prices of spaces and of lots to be sold within said Cemetery.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 9, 1952, and the Amendment thereto, being Ordinance No. 3, 1956, certain fees were established for the interment of remains other than for infants, and

WHEREAS, by said Ordinance No. 9, 1952 and the Amendment thereto, being Ordinance No. 3, 1956, certain fees were established for the interment of remains requiring larger space, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 9, 1952, certain charges were established for the interment of remains of infants and for spaces sold in said cemetery, and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such charges and fees are inadequate and not in line with similar charges in other cemeteries,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

That Ordinance No. 9, 1952, passed and adopted by the Common Council on the 21st day of October, 1952, and the Amendment thereto, being Ordinance No. 3, 1956, passed and adopted by said Common Council on the 21st day of February, 1956, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. That for each space sold, sufficient in size to accommodate one (1) grave, the charge shall be Eighty Dollars (\$80.00).

SECTION 2. That the charge for a lot which comprices space for six (6) graves shall be Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$480.00).

SECTION 3. That the charges for interment shall be as follows:

- a. For the interment of ashes, Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
- b. For the interment of remains of infants Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).
- c. For the interment of remains requiring larger space, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 4. Interment shall include the opening and closing of the grave.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor of Bloomington.
