## ORDINANCE NO. 10, 1956

An Ordinance to Amend the Bloomington Zoning Map, Dated July 18, 1950

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain real estate, now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to reclassify the following described real estate in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, to wit:

Part of Seminary Lot Number Sixty-three (63) in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to wit: beginning at the northeast corner of said Lot #63, running thence west to the branch; thence south with the branch 66 feet, thence east to the east line of said Seminary Lot; thence north to the place of beginning. Which property is located at 626 South Walnut Street in said City,

from a B1-Limited Business Zone to a B3-General Business Zone.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance, as amended, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
