

ORDINANCE NO. 11, 1956

An Ordinance to Amend the Bloomington Zoning Map, Dated July 18, 1950

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain property, now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to reclassify the following described real estate from R1 ONE-FAMILY ZONE to B1 LIMITED BUSINESS ZONE; to-wit:

All of the property which abutts either side of Rogers Street beginning with and including Lot No. 69 Matthew Campbell Addition on the east side and beginning with and including Lot No. 4 Duncan Addition on the west side and extending north to Dixie Street on the west side and to and including Lot no. 21, Matthew Campbell Addition on the east side all in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
