

ORDINANCE NO. 12, 1956

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 10, 1953, as It Pertains to Regulations for the Size and Speed of Boats, and Providing Penalties Therefor.

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington adopted Ordinance No. 10, 1953, on the 19th day of May, 1953, which said Ordinance contained certain provisions with respect to the size of all boats or crafts thereon and the speed at which a boat or craft may be operated thereon, and providing penalties therefor; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington has determined that such Ordinance, as originally written should be modified;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. Sections 18, 23 and 40 as they appear in Ordinance No. 10, 1953, are hereby repealed, and it is hereby ordained and enacted that the following Sections shall be substituted to stand in lieu thereof in the aforesaid Ordinance No. 10, 1953:

Section 18. There shall be no limit as to the length of a sail boat but no other boats or crafts shall be permitted on the Reservoir that are more than Eighteen (18) feet long from bow to stern and no floating or stationary raft shall be permitted on the Reservoir.

Section 23. No boat or craft shall be operated on the surface of the Reservoir at a speed or in a manner in conflict with Indiana State Laws concerning operation of water craft, provided, however, that the maximum speed that any boat or craft shall be operated on the surface of Bean Blossom Reservoir shall be Twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section 40. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, unless otherwise indicated, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day that the condition or act in violation of this Ordinance shall remain or continue shall be deemed on the part of the person or persons guilty of such violation to be a separate and distinct offense. Each offense shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), to which may be added a revocation of any license issued pursuant to this Ordinance.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and publication, in accordance with law.
