

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 4, 1955

CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA

An Ordinance Specially appropriating from the General Funds and Special Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and reducing funds heretofore appropriated for the use of Departments of said City, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various Departments.

 BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana;

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year, 1955, than was set out in detail in the Budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums to the funds and Departments of the City of Bloomington, Indiana:

1. Board of Health
  - (a) #262 - Car Rental (Milk Inspector) \$ 450.00
2. Fire Department
  - (a) #72 - Equipment (Motor & Hose) 5,516.33

Section 2. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Special Funds of the respective Departments of said City, not otherwise appropriated, the following sums to the Funds and Departments of the City of Bloomington, Indiana:

1. Bruner Courts
  - (a) #121 - Salaries Temporary (Labor) 300.00
  - (b) #58 - Social Security Taxes 6.00
2. Rosehill Cemetery
  - (a) #38 Supplies, General 200.00
3. Park Department
  - (a) #214 - Telephone 100.00
  - (b) #44 - Materials 100.00
  - (c) #451 - Parts of Equipment 50.00
4. Police Pension Fund
  - (a) #533 - Pensions to Dependents 990.00

Section 3. That there be, and hereby is, reduced from certain funds of the various Departments of said City, hereinafter referred to, for the reason that the amounts previously appropriated are in excess of actual needs at this time, and these funds may be returned to the unappropriated funds of the General or Special Funds from which they were appropriated, as follows:

1. Rosehill Cemetery
  - (a) #43 - Road Materials 200.00
2. Park Department
  - (a) #242 - Printing 42.50
  - (b) #38 - Supplies, General 100.00
  - (c) #725 - Office Equipment 7.50
  - (d) #726 - Other Equipment 100.00

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the State Board of Tax Commissioners.
