

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 1954

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 17, 1953, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAP, DATED JULY 18, 1950.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Map was amended on August 4, 1953, by the rezoning of Inlots numbered 13 and 14, from R3 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE to B2 DOWNTOWN BUSINESS ZONE at the request of the Day Funeral Home, and

WHEREAS, said Day Funeral Home now finds that it cannot use said Inlots numbered 13 and 14, as originally intended, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of Inlots numbered 13 and 14, to their former R3 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE classification, now,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Ordinance Number 17, 1953, an Ordinance amending the Bloomington Zoning Map Dated July 18, 1950, be, and the same is here by repealed.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
