

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON
 COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA
 No. 8, 1952

An Ordinance Concerning the Annexation of
 Adjacent and Contiguous Territory Pursuant
 to the Filing of a Voluntary Petition for
 Annexation.

WHEREAS, the Eastern boundary of the City of Bloomington is
 along the West side of High Street South of Third Street, and

WHEREAS, the South boundary of the City of Bloomington, East
 of High Street and North of Third Street extends in a Easterly
 direction from High Street along the North side of East Third
 Street, and

WHEREAS, PAUL SCHULTE, Arch-Bishop of the Diocese of
 Indianapolis, of the Roman Catholic Church, has submitted to
 the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition
 for Annexation of certain territory of which he is the owner under
 the laws and regulations of the Roman Catholic Church.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON
 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON:

Section 1. That the following described territory be,
 and the same is, hereby annexed to, and declared a part of, the
 City of Bloomington, Indiana:

Part of the Northwest quarter of Section Three (3)
 Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West, described
 as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the North-
 east quarter of said Section Three (3) town and range
 aforesaid; thence running South over and along the West
 line of the Northeast quarter for a distance of Four Hundred
 Three and Two-Tenths (403.2) feet; thence running East for
 a distance of One Hundred Sixty nine and Sixty Two Hundredths
 (169.62) feet; thence running South for a distance of Two
 Hundred Fifty Six and Eighty Hundredths (256.80) feet;
 thence running East for a distance of Eight Hundred Eighty
 Six and Thirty-Eight Hundredths (886.38) feet; thence
 running North for a distance of Six Hundred Sixty (660)
 feet and to the North line of the said Northeast Quarter;
 thence running West over and along the North line of the
 said Northeast Quarter for a distance of Ten Hundred Fifty-
 Six (1056) feet and to the place of beginning; Containing
 in all fifteen (15) acres, more or less

Section 2. Be it further ordained that the boundaries of
 the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared
 to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove
 described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and
 effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication, in
 accordance with the law.
