AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN OFFICIAL THOROUGHFARE
PLAN FOR THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF ACTS OF THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY, STATE OF INDIANA, CHAPTER 174, ACTS OF 1947 AND
CHAPTER 169, ACTS OF 1923 AND ALL ACTS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLE-
MENTARY THERETO:

Section 201. DESIGNATION.

There is hereby adopted an official thoroughfare plan for the
City of Bloomington, said plan having been adopted by reso-
lution No. 2, 1950, of the City Plan Commission and duly ap-
proved by the Board of Public Works, and all thoroughfares
hereafter located, relocated, platted, widened and opened
shall conform to the said thoroughfare plan.

Section 202. DESCRIPTION.

The official thoroughfare plan is shown on the accompanying
maps and charts entitled "Thoroughfare Plan, City Only,
Sheet No. 1; Thoroughfare Plan, City and Environs, Sheet No.
2; and Thoroughfare Plan, Recommended Cross Sections, Sheet
No. 3", which are parts of this ordinance, showing the location,
alignment, width and typical cross sections of existing and
proposed thoroughfares.

Section 203. THOROUGHFARE DEVELOPMENT.

The widening, location, opening and realignment of thorough-
fares shall be undertaken only in accordance with the thorough-
fare widths, location and alignment shown on the accompanying
maps and charts. Where the maps and charts indicate an irre-
gular alignment for the location or relocation of a thorough-
fare, detailed surveys and plans for such thoroughfares shall
be approved by the City Plan Commission before they shall be
deemed to conform to the thoroughfare plan.

Section 204. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval
by the Mayor.
