# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND <u>ORDINANCE 19-21</u>, WHICH FIXED SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS, NON-UNION, AND A.F.S.C.M.E. EMPLOYEES FOR ALL THE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY FOR THE YEAR 2020

- Re: Adding a Position in the Information and Technology Services Department and Changing the Title in One Position and the Grade in another Position for Two Divisions within the Police Department
- WHEREAS, IC § 36-7-4-3 authorizes the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Council, to fix the compensation of each appointed officer, deputy, and other employee of the city; and
- WHEREAS, Salaries for certain City of Bloomington employees were set by <u>Ordinance 19-</u>21; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to change the grade of the Records Supervisor position in the Record Division of the Bloomington Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to wishes to change the title of the Training Coordinator position in the Central Emergency Dispatch Center of the Bloomington Police Department; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor also wishes to add a Network and Security Administrator to the Information and Technology Services Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of <u>Ordinance 19-21</u>, which fixed salaries for Appointed Officers, Non-Union, and AFSCME Employees for 2020, shall be amended to add a Network and Security Administrator in the Information and Technology Services Department, which shall be reflected in that ordinance as follows:
