APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 05-03

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND, RISK MANAGEMENT FUND, TELECOM FUND, AND MUNICIPAL ARTS FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED

(Appropriating Funds from the General Fund for the Animal Care & Control Division and the Community & Family Resources Department for Various Purposes; from the Risk Management Fund for Increased Hours for the Assistant City Attorney; from the Telecom – Infrastructure Fund for expansion of the Bloomington Digital Underground (BDU) and Wireless Internet Access in City Hall; and from the Municipal Arts Fund to Reimburse the General Fund for a Percent for the Arts Project)

- WHEREAS, the Animal Care and Control Division has received and wishes to expend a \$7,500 grant from Petsmart to purchase computer software; and
- WHEREAS, as a result of new adoption policies the Animal Care and Control Division has seen an increase in costs for medical supplies and spay and neuter services along with offsetting adoption fee revenue; and
- WHEREAS, the Animal Care and Control Division has paid \$5,000 for the Percent for the Arts project installed at the Animal Shelter from its 2005 General Fund budget and wishes to be reimbursed from the Municipal Arts Fund; and
- WHEREAS, the Community & Family Resources has increased the hours from 30 to 40 per week for two Program Assistants in order to focus more staff time on community events, and needs additional funding to maintain continuity in the Plaza Comunitario program by retaining an intern; and
- WHEREAS, the Legal Department wishes to increase the hours from 30 to 40 for the Risk Management Division's Assistant City Attorney due to increased responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Information & Technology Services Department wishes to install conduit for the BDU along the new road under construction in the Indiana Enterprise Center; purchase conduit, manholes and handholes for the BDU; and improve the availability and quality of wireless Internet access within City Hall;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:







SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates \$136,500 from the General Fund – Animal Care & Control Division for a grant, for additional expenses related to new adoption policies, and for a reimbursement from the Municipal Arts Fund; \$24,534 from the General Fund – Community & Family Resources Department for increased hours for two employees and for interns; \$14,250 from the Risk Management Fund for increased hours for the Assistant City Attorney; \$63,320 from the Telecomm Infrastructure Fund for the Bloomington Digital Underground and wireless internet access; and \$5,000 from the Municipal Arts Fund to reimburse the General Fund for a Percent for the Arts Project.
