ORDINANCE 02-15

TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.12 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "BLOOMINGTON BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY COMMISSION" (Approving a Formal Role for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Commission in the Planning Petition Review Process)

WHEREAS, Councilmember Willsey and the mayor have held discussions with members of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Commission; and
WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Commission has expressed a desire to be more involved in reviewing planning petitions to better ensure that issues of concern to its members are more fully considered; and
WHEREAS, the Planning Department welcomes this suggestion and welcomes the input of the Commission, and fully supports a more formal role for the Commission in the plan review process, and has already implemented much of what this expanded role will entail;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Bloomington Municipal Code 2.12.080 (6) (B) shall be amended to insert ", Plan Commission" after "Common Council".

SECTION II. If any sections, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
