

ORDINANCE 02-38

TO ESTABLISH THE BLOOMINGTON COMMUNITY ARTS COMMISSION
NON-REVERTING OPERATING FUND

WHEREAS, under the provisions of B.M.C. 2.12.020, the purpose and duties of the Bloomington Community Arts Commission shall be to stimulate and encourage an appreciation of and participation in the fine arts by citizens of all ages in Bloomington and the surrounding area: to sponsor and develop artistic activities and educational programs, and in all other feasible ways foster an environment conducive to enjoyment of the fine arts; to cooperate with various bodies, groups and individuals interested in achieving the same ends in the area of the fine arts; and to administer the operation of any civic properties in Bloomington assigned for the fine arts; and

WHEREAS, Bloomington Community Arts Commission (BCAC) co-sponsors a biannual postcard competition for Monroe County artists;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Establishment of Fund. There is hereby established a BCAC Operating Non-Reverting Fund (Fund) in the Office of the Controller.

SECTION II. Source of Revenues. All monies received by the City of Bloomington from the annual postcard competition sponsors, proceeds from postcard sales, and donations to the Bloomington Community Arts Commission shall be deposited into this Fund.

SECTION III. Purpose of Fund. Monies contained in the Fund shall be used for awards and expenses related to the Postcard Competition or other projects fulfilling the purpose and duties of the BCAC.


SECTION IV. Expenditures from Fund. Expenditures from this Fund up to the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year shall be subject to approval of the Bloomington Community Arts Commission and the Board of Public Works and expenditures in excess of that amount per year shall be subject to appropriation by the Common Council.

SECTION V. Amendment and Termination. The Fund shall continue in this form until amended or terminated by ordinance. Unless indicated otherwise by ordinance, the proceeds of the Fund at termination shall be deposited into the General Fund.

SECTION VI. Severability. If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION VII. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS
