

RESOLUTION 02-19


TO AMEND THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY ADOPTING REVISIONS TO THE 1991 GROWTH POLICIES PLAN

- WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-7-4-501, the Plan Commission is responsible for preparing comprehensive plans and amendments thereto and forwarding them to the Common Council; and
- WHEREAS, with the passage of Resolution 91-15 on May 15, 1991, the Common Council adopted the comprehensive plan, also known as the Growth Policies Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the City Planning Department and Plan Commission were directed to evaluate and update this Plan starting in 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has completed this process, conducted public hearings, and developed revisions to this Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the revised Growth Policies Plan has been passed by the Plan Commission on June 10, 2002 and forwarded to the Common Council for adoption;



SECTION 1. The amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan, as certified by the Plan Commission, shall be approved as amended by the Common Council.



SYNOPSIS

This resolution amends the City's comprehensive plan by adopting revisions to the 1991 Growth Policies Plan. These revisions include changes to the Plan's Guiding Principles, Land Use Categories, Critical Subareas, and Master Thoroughfare Plan.

Note: The Common Council approved the Plan Commission's proposal with 14 amendments on November 6, 2002 and, in accordance with I.C. 36-7-4-510 and 511, returned the proposal, amendments, and an explanation for the amendments to the Plan Commission with a request that it respond within 60 days.
