

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 02-07

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED (Appropriating Funds for Shelter Inc. for Emergency Operations)

WHEREAS, the Common Council established the Affordable Housing Fund (Fund) by Resolution 91-25; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 91-25 provides that the Fund shall derive its revenues from mortgage payments received from Amethyst House for the sale of the property located at 215 North Rogers Street; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 91-25 provides that the purpose of the Fund is to assist in affordable housing efforts for low- to moderate-income persons, and

WHEREAS, like many other social service agencies, Shelter Inc. has experienced a decline in contributions in the current economic climate; and

WHEREAS, emergency funding is needed for the ongoing operations of the emergency shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide a grant to Shelter, Inc. for emergency operating expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:
