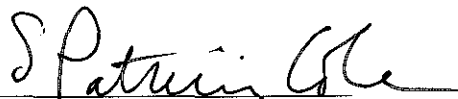
TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF CITY OF BLOOMINGTON'S APPLICATION FOR AN INDIANA BROWNFIELD ASSESSMENT GRANT FROM THE INDIANA DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY

- WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington has determined that it should continue to be proactive in the restoration of environmentally impaired sites to productive and beneficial use; and
- WHEREAS, the Indiana Development Finance Authority provides grants to Indiana local governments for the assessment of environmentally contaminated properties; and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that a unified administrative/legislative effort would be in the City's best interest when applying for Brownfield Assessment Grants; and
- WHEREAS, the McDoel rail yard is located in the City of Bloomington and owned by CSX corporation; and
- WHEREAS, the McDoel rail yard should be designated as a priority for identification and remediation of possible adverse environmental factors, so that it can be used for future development and be restored to a use that benefits the community;

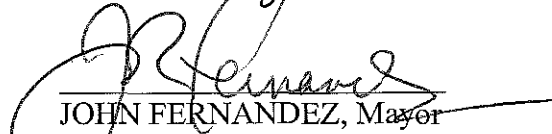
