APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 01-02

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES
NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED
(To transfer monies within the Community and Family Resources Department)

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to transfer General Fund monies; and

WHEREAS, in particular, the Community and Family Resources Department has requested the transfer of \$5,000 from Category 100 (Personal Services) to Category 300 (Other Services and Charges) to provide grants to the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:




