

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 01-06

Passed 8-1 (Banach)

TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES
NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED

(To Appropriate Funding for the Cost of a Management Agreement Between the City and
the Bloomington Area Arts Council)

WHEREAS, the Indiana Theatre building is a historic landmark located in downtown
Bloomington that has been rehabilitated and re-named the Buskirk-Chumley
Theatre and now serves as a performing arts and community program venue
serving Bloomington and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the presence of this building is a major contributor to the economic and cultural
vitality of the central Bloomington business district and the loss of this asset will
cause significant economic harm to the downtown business district; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that support for the arts and culture is in the public interest and
plays a major role in improving the quality of life and business development
environment in communities where such support is provided; and

WHEREAS, the failure to provide capital and operating support to the Buskirk-Chumley
Theatre will cause significant economic harm to the Bloomington Area Arts
Council (BAAC) and jeopardize its mission to provide arts education programs
and arts programming in Bloomington and the five counties that surround
Monroe County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington is entering into a management agreement with the
Bloomington Area Arts Council to operate and provide capital maintenance for
the Theatre, and that the use of funds from this appropriation will be used by
the BAAC exclusively to pay operating, capital and debt service costs incurred
by the Theatre; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington will provide additional operating and capital support
for the Theatre through the use of tax increment financing funds authorized by
the Bloomington Redevelopment Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of
money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the
purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance appropriates \$600,000 from the general fund for the City to enter into a management agreement with the Bloomington Area Arts Council that will result in the City taking full and complete operating and management control of the Buskirk-Chumley Theatre. Funds from this appropriation shall be used by the Bloomington Area Arts Council only for operating, capital and debt service costs incurred directly by the Theatre.
