TO AMEND ORDINANCE 99-28 WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF **THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2000 Re: Upgrading Three Positions in the Utilities Department**

WHEREAS, the Job Evaluation Committee has reviewed the amended job description for positions in the Utilities Department and has recommended changes in the grade for some of those positions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 99-28 shall be amended by changing the grade and pay maximum for the following positions, as indicated below:

Utilities	Assistant Customer Service Coordinator	4	\$31,053
Utilities	Purchasing Manager	7	\$43,566
Utilities	Finance Manager	8	\$41,835

SECTION 2. If any sections, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.
