#### Special Session and Committee of the Whole Next Wednesday, September 14th

There are two meetings scheduled for next Wednesday. The first is a Special Session where three ordinances are ready for second readings, four ordinances (including the Civil City budget ordinance for 2012 – <u>App Ord 11-05</u>) will be announced as rescheduled in accordance with a motion the Council adopted last Wednesday, and one ordinance will be introduced. The second meeting is a Committee of the Whole where the one newly introduced ordinance will be ready for discussion.

#### **First Readings**

Item One – <u>Ord 11-16</u> – Amending <u>Ord 11-02</u> and <u>Ord 10-18</u> to Extend Timeframe for Issuance of Economic Development Revenue Bonds for Pinnacle School

Ord 11-06 amends Ord 11-02 and Ord 10-18 in order to extend the timeframe for Pinnacle School¹ to issue State Economic Revenue Bonds to expand their new facility on Arlington Road. As you may recall, Pinnacle School came forward last year for Council authorization to use up to \$2.1 million of bonds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act² for this purpose (Ord 10-18), but was unable to arrange financing in time. Then, in early 2011, Pinnacle School returned to the Council to request that up to \$1.5 million in financing be authorized through State tax exempt Economic Development Revenue Bonds (Ord 11-02) for the same purpose. That legislation provided for the issuance of bonds within 180 days of adoption of the ordinance, which will expire on September 19<sup>th</sup>. The ordinance coming forward next week extends that timeframe by another 180 days.

#### **ORDINANCE 11-16**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING <u>ORDINANCE 10-18</u>, AS AMENDED BY <u>ORDINANCE 11-02</u>, EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVENUE BONDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF BLOOMINGTON DYSLEXIA CENTER, LLC AND AUTHORIZING OTHER ACTIONS IN RESPECT THERETO

- WHEREAS, the Common Council ("Council") of the City of Bloomington, Indiana ("City"), on December 1, 2010, adopted Ordinance 10-18, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to issue its Economic Development Recovery Zone Facility Revenue Bonds, Series 2010 (Bloomington Dyslexia Center LLC Project) in the principal amount not in excess of Two Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,100,000), and approving and authorizing other actions in respect thereto" (the "2010 Bond Ordinance"), and
- WHEREAS, the Council, on March 23, 2011, adopted Ordinance11-02, entitled "An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 10-18 authorizing the City of Bloomington, Indiana to issue its Economic Development Revenue Bonds, Series 2011 (Bloomington Dyslexia Center, LLC Project) in the principal amount not in excess of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) and approving other actions with respect thereto" (the "2011 Ordinance", and with the 2010 Ordinance, the "Prior Ordinances"): and
- WHEREAS, Section 1(F) of the 2011 Ordinance amended Section 5 of the 2010 Ordinance to provide that "the Bonds shall be dated the date of closing of this transaction, which date to be no later than one hundred eighty days from the date of adoption of this Ordinance, as amended"; and
- WHEREAS, Bloomington Dyslexia Center LLC has requested the City to extend the time limit imposed under the Prior Ordinances in order to permit negotiations for the purchase and sale of the Bonds to be completed; and
- WHEREAS, the City now desires to extend the time limit for the issuance of the Bonds, and to amend the Prior Ordinances to allow such extension and to reaffirm its prior commitment to authorize the issuance of such bonds for the benefit of Bloomington Dyslexia Center, LLC.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. The Prior Ordinances are hereby amended in the following particulars:
- A. Section 1(H) of <u>Ordinance 11-02</u> is amended by deleting the phrase "one hundred eighty (180) days" and inserting in its place, "three hundred sixty (360) days".
- SECTION 2. All other provisions of the Prior Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed as though set forth herein, and the provisions of the Prior Ordinances, as amended hereby, shall constitute a contract binding between the Issuer and the Bond Purchaser, and after the issuance of said Bonds, the Prior Ordinances, as amended hereby, shall not be repealed or amended in any respect which would adversely affect the right of any holder or holders of the Bonds so long as said Bonds or the interest thereon remains unpaid.
- SECTION 3. This Ordinance amending the Prior Ordinances shall be in full force and effect upon adoption and compliance with IC 36-4-6-14.

#### Synopsis

This Ordinance amends <u>Ordinance 10-18</u>, adopted by the Council on December 1, 2010, and <u>Ordinance 11-02</u>, adopted by the Council on March 23, 2011, and extends the time limit for the issuance of up to \$1,500,000 in tax exempt Economic Development Revenue Bonds for the Pinnacle School Campus project at 1503/1505 West Arlington Road for an additional one hundred eighty days.

The City of Bloomington Common Council has adopted two ordinances approving the issuance of tax exempt economic development bonds for the benefit of Bloomington Dyslexia Center, LLC. Ordinance 10-18, adopted December 1, 2010, authorized the issuance of Recovery Zone Facility Bonds under Section 1400U of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (the "Stimulus Act"). Because the Bonds could not be issued prior to the expiration of the Stimulus Act, the Council, on March 23, 2011, adopted Ordinance No. 11-02, which amended Ordinance No. 10-18 to provide for the issuance of the Bonds as Economic Development Revenue Bonds under IC 36-7-12 et. seq. Ordinance No. 11-02 contains a provision which requires the Bonds to be issued within 180 days of its date of adoption. This time limit expires on September 19, 2011. While negotiations with a purchaser for the Bonds are ongoing, it is questionable whether the transaction can be consummated within the time limit contained in Ordinance No. 11-02. The proposed ordinance amends the prior ordinances by extending the time limit from 180 to 360 days. It makes no other changes to the transaction as previously authorized by the Council. Because the amending ordinance changes the time limit as set forth in Ordinance No.11-02, it will relate back to the date of adoption of that Ordinance. Therefore, the authorization of the Bonds by the Council will continue to be valid even if the amendment is adopted after the expiration of the time limit set forth in Ordinance 11-02.

The Bonds continue to be payable solely from revenues generated by the project, and are not a debt of the City, Monroe County or the State. They will not impact the City's credit rating or debt capacity. The financing documents provide indemnification to the City for any liability arising with respect to either the Bonds or the Project.
