The Council didn't meet on Wednesday due to the weather and Susan Sandberg has called a Special Session for next Wednesday to make up for the cancellation. It will be held immediately before the Committee of the Whole.

Special Session

As noted in last week's memo, there are two items ready for final action at what will now be called a Special Session. The first is a resolution (<u>Res 11-02</u>) which approves the interlocal agreement with Monroe County and Town of Ellettsville regarding payment for animal shelter services in 2011.
