 - b. Just over \$90,000 has been ordered in grants this year with the Projects grant cycle and the Operations grants cycle. The source is a split from BAC general funds and BUEA

 - d. We also still have the \$5,000 slated for artists workshops which Chaz and Christina are working on. Our first workshop was last month and we spent about \$1,500. A second workshop is planned for early November.

 - b. We are also hoping to roll out our Public Art Master Plan grants.

 - b. There are 90 applications to review. Grants will be \$1,000 each. Grants will be divided into subcategories so that no one art medium will dominate the awarded grants.
