- 3. Follow up on Traci Parker and possible April visit
 - a. Michelle followed up with Dr. Parker about doing Remembrance week activities. She will be at IU in April (April 9th) so the timing is good, but her new book doesn't come out until 2029. Dr. Parker isn't opposed to doing something with the Commission in April.
 - b. Michelle asked the Commission to think about how we would like to engage with Dr. Parker in April.
 - c. We will need to come up with a title for the Celebration event.

New Business:

- 1. MLK Day On/40 Days of Peace/Be the Change Volunteer Challenge Volunteer Committee set up Oct/Nov/Dec meetings scheduled
 - a. Brittany and Angel are interested. Michelle is already getting information out about MLK Day On. Michelle is trying to get the word out to different local organizations and give the sign up links out to volunteers.

- 2. Remembrance Week Committee- Who is interested? /set up first meeting
 - a. Gloria and Julie are interested.
 - b. Michelle would like for the committee to plan a Zoom meeting.
- 3. Newsletter update
 - a. The city has decided that they don't want individual departments to send out individualized newsletters, but it is not currently decided where centralized newsletters will come from.
 - b. Michelle will be sending out newsletters until further notice.
 - c. Michelle has a liaison meeting tomorrow and will be discussing this topic further.
- 4. Legacy award
 - a. Michelle would like to get the nomination form out at the beginning of October and run it through end of November
 - b. Will need to revisit the verbiage for the award and we will need to discuss whether we want to add language about longevity
- 5. Memory Activism- Generational Meeting
 - a. Latonya proposed this idea, a meeting between African American youth and African American elders. Way to bring different demographics together. Latonya works with the Atkins LLC on campus, she feels this could be easily done with the connections that we have within the Commission.
 - i. Julie can bring this idea to the NAACP, especially the Youth chapter. Latonya will connect with Julie to come to the next NAACP meeting.
 - ii. Gloria suggested that Latonya draft and send the Commission a proposal that can be sent to the NAACP to co-sponsor possibly. Idea to do it in the spring around remembrance time. The Black Student Union could potentially co-host as well.
 - iii. Idea to use the Boys and Girls club as a location to host the event, or Bannaker, or a church.
 - iv. James brought up that the kind of discussion would influence the location choice.
 - v. Gloria offered to connect Latonya to Maria at the NAACP to plan this further.
- 6. Winter Wonderland
 - a. Can do a beaded activity during the event.
 - b. James is on the planning committee and will keep the Commission informed on updates about this event.
- 7. Donations of warm clothes and accessories as part of MLK Day On
 - a. Thought to use IU Crimson Cupboard as a partner
 - b. Julie suggested the Boys and Girls club
 - c. Aniah found a few resources such as Healing Hands and Foster Closet
 - d. James suggested we find an organization that has a specific need to work with
 - e. Gloria said that Neal Marshall has a program that we could work with
 - f. Encourage participants to donate to specific places as opposed to us collecting donations
